O R D E R

The City of North Sacramento is authorized to construct Grove Avenue at grade across the main line track of Sacramento Northern Railway at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 8-97.0, replacing the existing pedestrian Crossing No. 8-97.0-D. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Sacramento Northern Railway shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four (24) feet and grades of approach substantially as shown on the profile attached to the application (Exhibit "B"). Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
