ORDER

The County of San Bernardino is authorized to widen Archibald Avenue (Crossing No. B-523.4) at grade across the Southern Pacific track in the County of San Bernardino at the location described in the application.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction expense also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance costs between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 38 feet and grades of approach not greater than 4%. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public

convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
