NINTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Applicants operate as highway contract and city carriers of lumber and forest products, for Owens-Parks Lumber Company, from Vernon to points within a 30-mile radius of that city. They have been authorized by prior orders in this proceeding to deviate from the minimum rates otherwise applicable to this transportation. The authority is scheduled to expire on June 26, 1947. A one-year extension is sought.

The verified supplemental application shows that there has been no material change in the conditions under which the service is rendered and that these unusually favorable conditions are expected to prevail for the ensuing year. It also shows that operations under the increased rate applicants were authorized to observe by Decision No. 39109 of June 18, 1946, have been compensatory.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary in that the sought extension is justified. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted by Decision No. 38032 of June 26, 1945, as amended, in the above entitled application, be and it is hereby extended to June 26, 1948, unless sooner changed or further extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective on June 26, 1947.
