OBDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one spur track at grade across Alameda Street and Lynwood Road in the City of Lynwood, Los Angeles County, at the locations described in the application. The crossing over Lynwood Road shall be identified as a portion of Crossing No. BG-491.8 and across Alameda Street as Crossing No. BG-491.9-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 3%. Protection for Crossing No. BG-491.8 shall be by 2 Standard No. 1 crossing signs and for Crossing No. BG-491.9-C by 1 Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-E).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authoriza-

tion shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

This order shall be effective 20 days from the date hereof.
