## ORDER

Contra Costa County is authorized to construct Mt. Diablo Street at grade across the main track of Sacramento Northern Railway near Concord, Contra Costa County, at the location shown in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 8-33.4. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Sacramento Northern Railway shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing pavement shall be not less than 24 feet nor greater than 50 feet, and grades of approach not greater than four per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
