O R D E R

Trinidad Water & Supply Co., a corporation, engaged in the business of supplying water for domestic and commercial purposes to customers in and in the vicinity of the City of Trinidad, Humboldt County, asks the Commission for authority to sell and transfer all of its properties to the City of Trinidad, a municipal corporation, which joins in the application. The city now owns the outstanding stock of the company.

The city desires to own and operate its own water system and has acquired all of the outstanding stock of the company. The company reports its investment in the properties at \$5,400 as of July 15, 1946. The system supplies water to 34 customers.

It appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application should be granted, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. That Trinidad Water & Supply Co., a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to sell and transfer, on or before August 1, 1947, its public utility water system to the City of Trinidad, a municipal corporation, said property being more particularly described in the application.
2. That within sixty (60) days after the sale and transfer of its water properties to the City of Trinidad, the Trinidad Water & Supply Co. shall file with the Public Utilities Commission a statement showing the exact date upon which it relinquished control and possession of its water system.

3. That upon compliance with the above terms and conditions said Trinidad Water & Supply Co., a corporation, shall thereupon and thereby stand relieved of all further public utility obligations and liabilities in connection with the water system herein authorized to be transferred:

The authority herein granted will become effective twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
