ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 37083 in Application No. 26132, Leonard J. Difani and Hugh S. Rawlings were authorized to acquire a passenger stage operative right between Arlington, a suburb of Riverside, and the United States Army Staging Depot at Camp Anza. Decision No. 39101 in Application No. 27470 authorized Difani and Rawlings to suspend operations under such right until December 15, 1946.

By supplemental Application No. 26132, the Commission is requested to revoke that operative right on the basis that there is no further public need for the service. Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate acquired by Difani and Rawlings pursuant to the authority contained in Decision No. 37083, is hereby revoked and annulled and all effective tariffs and time

tables on file with the Commission in the name of Difani and Rawlings are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
