OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 35927, dated November 5, 1942, Key System (the corporate name of which has been changed to Key System Transit Lines) was authorized to discontinue operation of that portion of its service over its Nos. 51, 52 and 58 Alameda-Oakland motor coach lines as follows:

"In Telegraph Avenue between 16th and 22nd Streets. In 22nd Street between Broadway and Telegraph Avenue. In Broadway between 22nd and 16th Streets."

By its 106th Supplemental Application No. 19502, Key System Transit Lines seeks authority to re-establish service over this route on June 15, 1947 at the request of the city of Oakland. Good cause appearing,
