OPINION AND ORDER

Fresno Warehouse Company, a corporation, seeks authority to withdraw from public utility warehouse service at Calwa, Fresno County, and to cancel its tariff on file with the Commission naming rates for this service.

The verified application shows that applicant has not been able to operate since its warehouse was destroyed by fire in 1946, that it does not desire to build a new warehouse, and that dissolution of the corporation is contemplated.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the sought authority should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Fresno Warehouse Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to discontinue public utility warehouse operations at Calwa, Fresno County, and to cancel its tariff naming rates for these operations.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
