ORDER OF REVOCATION

Decision No. 38172 and Decision No. 38931 granted certificates to R. J. Thompson to transport rail shipments of property received from or delivered to Union Pacific Railroad Company, between Los Angeles, Long Beach and intermediate rail points. By supplemental application, the Commission is requested to revoke those certificates because applicant has discontinued operations thereunder. Therefore, and good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the highway common carrier operative rights created by Decision No. 38172 and Decision No. 38931 are hereby revoked and annulled, and all effective tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name of R. J. Thompson are hereby canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
