ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one additional spur track at grade across 69th Avenue in Oakland, Alameda County, at the location described in the application to be operated jointly with The Western Pacific Railroad Company and to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 4-11.9-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding six per cent. Protection shall be by one additional Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O.75B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective twenty days from the date hereof.
