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By this appiscetion, Bay Repie Transit Company asks permission to extend its East lionterey bus line a distance of afproximately one mile, to servc a portion of the residential section known as Dej Monte Heights, in East Monterey.

Applicant is the succossor of Josoph meller; who for scveral years operated a bus service between Carmel; Monterey and Pacific Groves, and botwoen Monterey and Fort ord Village vie seaside (I) and East Monterey.

The applicetion statcs that there is no common cerrier service available to the pubilc over the proposed route; which treverses an area that is said to be experioncing continuing development. The portion of Del Monte ieights tirough which the extension Fuild run slopes somewhat sharply upward to the east of Fremont Stree". and the Monterey-Castrovilic Highway.: Applicant now provides frequeni service during the day and until late at night between lionterey and East Monterey over those two routes: Residents of Del Monte Heights living on and to the east of joche Bucne Avenue, however, must now walk uphill for some distance upon leaving the bus on Fremont street or the highway.: The proposcd extension, designed to alleviete thet situation, will take off from the intersection of Broadway and the

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Lionterey-Castrovilie Highway and will proceed easterly on Eroadiay to Noche Buena Avenue, thence south to the intersection of inilby and Noche Buena fvemes. Scrvice to and from lionterey over the extended route will be provided with present equipment daily except Sundays and holidays on converient morning and early evening scheduies. Fares w1ll be those now set forth in applicant's tariff: namely, an adult fare of 20 cents; sever tokens for 50 cents; chilaren's fare 5 cents; with trancfers to be issued uncer the terms and conditions provided in the tariff.

A protest, aileging inadequacy of the proposed schedules and demanding denial of the application, was filed by Pryant Guernsey. Protestant formerly operated a passenger stage service between Nonterey and Fort ord village (inciuding Del Monte neizkts) over practically the same routes used, and hercin sought to be used, by applicent: Guernsey's certificetes were recently revoked for longcontinued falure to provide the very service he nor secks to deny to applicant. (Dec. 40236, Niey 6, 1947, Case 4833.) The have considered the protest and find it to be without merit.

Upon full consideration of the appifeation we are of the

opinion and find thet public convonience and necessity require the extension of service here proposod, and the application will therefore be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

## ORDER

fpplicetion therefor having been filed and considered, and it heving been found thet public convenience and necessity so require, and the Commission nov beine fuliy advised,

IT IS ORDERED:
(1) That a certificatc of public convenience and necessity be and it is hereby granted to Bay Rapid Transit Company, a corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a nassenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 2-1/4 of the Public Utilities ket; for the transportation of passengers and baggage betwoor the intersection of State Highwey and Broedway, on the one hand, and the intersection of Hilby fiviuue and Noche Buena fivenue, on the other hend, ell in the communty known as East Monterey, Monterey County, cilifornia, as an extension of and to be consolideted with applicant's present operative authority in and in the vicinity, of konterey, California.
(2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and obscrve the following scrvice regulations:
a. Applicant siali file a written accoptance of the certificate hercin granted within a period of not to exceed 30 days from the effective date hercof.
b. Within 60 days from the effective date hereof and on not less than 1 day's notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shell
> establish the service herein authorized and comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-s, by filing in triplicate and concurrentiy meking effective, appropriate teriffs and time tables.
> c. Subject to the outhority of this Commssion to change or modify them by further order, applicant shall conduct operations pursuant to the certificste herein grented over and alons the following routes:

Reginning at the intersection of Stete Eighmay and Erocduay, thence ersterly alons Erocdway to Noshe buene ivenue; thence southerly along Noche Euena fvenue to its. intersection mith \#ilby svenue, and return via the same route.

Applicent is authorized to turn its motor vehicies at termini and intermediate points, in either direction, at the intersection of the strect or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersection, or in accordonce with local treffic mules.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the dete hereof.
