SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

In Application No. 24949, Walkup Drayage & Warehouse Co. has been authorized to transport bakery goods for National Biscuit Company and Loose-Wiles Biscuit Company at rates generally lower than the established minimum rates. This authorization is restricted to transportation from San Francisco and Oakland along designated routes extending to Willits, Calistoga, Suisun-Fairfield and San Jose. It is scheduled to expire July 11, 1947. In Application No. 25595, Walkup has been authorized to transport property for Butler Brothers within the City and County of San Francisco at a rate lower than the minimum rates generally applicable for San Francisco drayage service. This authorization will expire June 30, 1947. Sixty-day extensions are now sought.

Applicant alleges that negotiations concerning a new labor contract are being carried on with representatives of applicant's drivers, that a demand for an increase in drivers' wages is one of the matters involved in these negotiations, that an agreement is expected to be reached within the sixty-day extensions here proposed,

and that meanwhile the costs of future operations and any increases required in rates for the services in question cannot be determined.

It appears that these are matters in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the sought extensions should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration dates of the authorizations granted Walkup Drayage & Warehouse Company by Decision No. 39176 in Application No. 24949 and Decision No. 39151, as amended, in Application No. 25595 be and they are hereby extended to September 11, 1947, and September 1, 1947, respectively, unless sooner changed or further extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective June 30, 1947.
