O R D E R

The City of San Bruno is authorized to construct a pedestrian way at grade across a wye track of Southern Pacific Company in San Bruno, San Mateo County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No.

EM-13.15-DC. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not more than six feet. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 of G. O. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign. (G. O. 75-B.) Posts or other suitable barriers shall be installed on each side of the crossing in such a manner as to effectively prevent vehicular use of said crossing.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective twenty days from the date hereof.
