OPINION AND ORDER

Mare Island Ferry, a corporation, which operates a passenger ferry service between the City of Vallejo and Mare Island seeks authority to enter into a joint fare arrangement with the City of Vallejo which operates a passenger bus service within Vallejo and between Vallejo and adjacent communities.

In conformance with a proposed agreement between the parties, the Council of the City of Vallejo on May 28, 1947, passed Resolution No. 556 N. C., a certified copy of which is attached to the application as Exhibit "A", which provides that the fare arrangement described therein will become effective 5 days' after the approval thereof by this Commission. The proposed fares to be charged for books of commutation tickets are as follows:

(a) City local lines - Mare Island Ferry  
 10 round trip rides (20 single rides) - \$2.25

(b) City Chabot Terrace Line - Mare Island Ferry  
 10 round trip rides (20 single rides) - \$3.50

Applicant states that it believes that a new and additional source of passenger revenue will be available to it and the City of Vallejo, and that individuals now using private automobiles to travel to and from their employment at Mare Island will be attracted by the convenience and economy of, and will utilize the proposed combined operation of the bus and ferry.

After full consideration we find that applicant's proposal is in the public interest and it will be authorized. No public hearing is necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing:

IT IS ORDERED that the agreement hereinabove referred to be, and it hereby is, approved, and that tariff filings incorporating the joint fare arrangements involved may be made effective on not less than 5 days' notice to the Commission and the public.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
