SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 40512 entered today in Case No. 4293, state-wide minimum rates have been established for the transportation of fresh fruits and vegetables and empty second-hand carriers for those commodities. For the reasons set out in that decision, the pear and pear carrier rates named in Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 2 (Appendix "D" to Decision No. 31606, as amended, in Case No. 4246) are to be superseded by the general state-wide rates. The Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 2 rates will, accordingly, be canceled.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 31606, as amended, in Case No. 4246, be and it is hereby further amended by substituting in Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 2 (Appendix "D" to said Decision, as amended), to become effective August 25, 1947, the following revised pages, which pages are attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof:
