O R D E R

The verified application of VISALIA ELECTRIC RAILROAD COMPANY discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's stations of Phalanx and Liberty for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Visalia Electric Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency stations of Phalanx and Liberty, County of Tulare; to remove side tracks located at said stations; to eliminate said names from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said stations on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
