SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By its Second Supplemental Application, Fialer's Limousines, Inc., requests an additional 90-day extension of time within which to inaugurate bus service for airline passengers between Mills Field and various Peninsula cities. (Decision No. 40009, Feb. 25, 1947, as amended by Decision No. 40239, May 6, 1947). As justification for the extension applicant states that but one vehicle has been received from the manufacturer since the filing of the First Supplemental Application herein. The increase in volume of operations since the filing of the original application, it is alleged, makes it preferable to continue existing services at their present efficiency rather than to impair such services by diverting equipment to the new operation. Delivery of additional vehicles, it is stated, is expected by October 15, 1947.

Applicant's request appears to be reasonable, and it will accordingly be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that paragraph (b) of the second ordering paragraph of Decision No. 40009, heretofore amended by Decision No. 40239, be and it is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"b. Within 240 days from the effective date hereof and on not less than 5 days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A, by filing in triplicate and concurrently making effective, appropriate tariffs and time tables."

In all other respects said Decision No. 40009 shall be and remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
