FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

A supplemental application having been filed by Mr. Sam Hamburg, asking the Commission to amend its Order in Decision No. 36691, dated November 8, 1943, to permit him to use, during the period from June 15 to September 15, 1947, on 6,000 acres of land owned by him, 1,450 acre feet of water of The San Joaquin Canal Company which he would be entitled to use from September 15 to December 31, 1947, a public hearing having been held thereon, the matter having been submitted, and briefs having been filed, and thereafter a letter having been received from Mr. Sam Hamburg, informing the Commission that he has been allocated an additional 1,680 acre feet of water by the Bureau of Reclamation, and asking that the above supplemental application be dismissed, and other good cause appearing, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the said supplemental application filed by Mr. Sam Hamburg in the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby dismissed.
