## OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant Harrison operates public utility warehouses in Colusa and Sutter Counties. They are situated along the Sacramento River at Coles Landing, Nelson's Landing and State Ranch Bend.

Authority is here sought to discontinue operations at Coles Landing.

The verified application shows that with the discontinuance of service, the property is proposed to be sold to A. Earl Lane; that the public interest will not be adversely affected since Lane is the principal bailor at that warehouse; and that other public storage facilities are available in the area. It is further represented that recently only three storers, other than Lane, have used the facilities involved and that at the present time Lane is the only storer.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that R. L. Harrison, doing business as Harrison Warchouses, be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue public utility warchouse operations at Coles Landing and to cancel

his tariff rates, rules and regulations applicable at that warehouse.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
