ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Defendants' application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity, first denied in 1945 (Dec. No. 37892, Apps. Nos. 18873 and 24202), was granted on rehearing on June 28, 1947 (Dec. No. 40485), and further rehearing was denied on August 12, 1947 (Dec. No. 40611). Complaint, alleging unauthorized highway common carrier operations between the points now covered by defendants' certificate, was filed on January 28, 1947, during the pendency of the above applications.

Because of the issuance of a certificate, further proceedings in connection with the complaint appear unnecessary, and good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that Case No. 4870 is hereby dismissed.
