O P I N I O N

Theo. L. Maxwell, an individual, doing business under the name of Maxwell Services, applicant herein, requests authority to establish and operate a passenger stage service for the transportation of passengers and express, between Oxnard and Camarillo State Hospital, and intermediate points. The proposed service is to be on schedule and applicant proposes seven daily schedules leaving Oxnard and seven daily schedules leaving the State Hospital.

Applicant states that public convenience and necessity require the establishment of the proposed service inasmuch as the employees of, and passengers to, the Camarillo State Hospital are entirely without any means of transportation other than taxicab service.

The application is supported by the business manager of the hospital who indicates there is a definite need for public transportation by the 525 employees of the hospital.

The truck and bus lines in the area have been contacted and no opposition has been expressed. The route proposed by

applicant is one which the application indicates will serve all prospective passengers in the best possible way.

According to the record, applicant is willing and able to conduct the proposed operation.

Upon full consideration of this matter we are of the opinion and find that the establishment and operation of a passenger stage service, as requested herein, is in the public interest and, therefore, the application will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Application as above entitled having been filed, the Commission being fully advised in the premises and hereby finding that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity be, and it hereby is, granted to Theo. L. Maxwell, an individual, authorizing the establishment and operation of a service as a passenger stage corporation as that term is defined in Section 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of passengers and express, between Oxnard and the Camarillo State Hospital, and intermediate points, subject to the following restrictions:

- (a) Service shall be limited to the transportation of passengers and express originating at, or destined to, the Camarillo State Hospital.
- (b) Express shipments shall be limited to a maximum of 100 pounds each.

(2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, Theo. L. Maxwell shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from the effective date hereof.
- (b) Applicant shall, within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof and upon not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and the public, establish the service herein authorized and comply with the provisions of General Orders Nos. 79 and 80, and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A, by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission.
- (c) Subject to the authority of this Commission to change or modify such at any time, Theo. L. Maxwell shall conduct said passenger stage operation over and along the following described routes:

Commencing at 5th & A Streets in Oxnard, thence via 5th Street, East 5th Street (State Route 153-A), Pleasant Valley Road, Las Posas Road, Arnoill Road, U. S. Highway 101, State Route 153-B, Lewis Road and West Road to Camarillo State Hospital, returning via same route.

Alternate Route No. 1

Commencing at 5th & A Streets in Oxnard, thence via 5th Street, East 5th Street (State Route 153-A), Las Posas Road, Cawolti Road, Lewis Road and West Road to Camarillo State Hospital, returning via same route.

Alternate Route No. 2

Commencing at 5th and A Streets in Oxnard, thence via 5th Street, East 5th Street (State Route 153-A), Pleasant Valley Road, Las Posas Road, U. S. Highway 101, State Route 153-B, Lewis Road and West Road to Camarillo State Hospital, returning via same route.

Applicant is authorized to turn his motor vehicles at termini and intermediate points, in either direction, at intersections of streets or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersection, or in accordance with local traffic rules.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
