ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 26189 as amended by Decision No. 26202 in Application No. 18934, Henry F. Siemsen was granted a certificate as a highway common carrier in general between Petaluma, Tomales, Valley Ford, Occidental and Bodega and intermediate points.

In the above-entitled proceeding applicant states that he has discontinued operations under such certificate because of a lack of public demand for the service and also because of the poor condition of his health and requests the Commission to revoke his operative rights. Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the highway common carrier operative rights created by Decision No. 26189, as amended by Decision No. 26202, are hereby revoked and annulled, and all effective tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name of Henry F. Siemsen are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
