O P I N I O N

The above entitled formal complaint was filed with this Commission on April 14, 1942, requesting that defendants be required to continue to furnish water for domestic and agricultural purposes to the properties of complainants.

A public hearing was held in this matter on October 8, 1943, at Los Angeles. Complainants agreed to a continuance of this case until after the War as defendants' principal witness was in service of the United States Navy and was not available to testify. Defendants agreed to continue to furnish water to complainant, Betty Newcombe Beckman, during the period the matter was being held in abeyance. The record of this hearing further indicates that James E. Cram no longer has any interest in this Case.

A written stipulation for dismissal was executed on August 26, 1947, by Betty Newcombe Beckman for Complainants, a copy of which has been filed with the Commission. In view of this stipulation, it appears that further hearing is unnecessary and the case may be dismissed.
