ORDER

In this application the Feather River Railway Company requests permission to abandon its line of railroad between Feather Falls and Ward, Butte County, California. (1)

Applicant alleges that the only business done by it is the transportation of logs for the Feather River Pine Mills, Inc., and that this company is now using trucks to transport its logs, therefore the railroad is no longer necessary.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Feather River Railway Company be hereby authorized to abandon and remove its line of railroad between Feather Falls and Ward, Butte County, California, and to cancel all of its freight and passenger tariffs.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission in writing of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
