O R D E R

The City of Huntington Beach is authorized to construct a crossing at grade in the vicinity of Third and Chicago Streets across two spur tracks of Pacific Electric Railway Company's Newport Beach Line in Orange County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6E-32.96-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction expense, also maintenance costs outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear the maintenance costs between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 40 feet and grades of approach not greater than 3%. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
