

Decision No. 40744

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of Application of SACRAMENTO CITY LINES for an order granting permission to (a) increase its local passenger rates of fare from 7¢, or 4 tokens for 25¢, to 10¢, or 3 tokens for 25¢; (b) increase its students' rate of fare from 8 tickets for 25¢ to 5¢ a ride; (c) discontinue sale of a weekly pass, now sold for \$1.50; (d) cancel special or chartered car rates appearing in its tariff; and (e) discontinue sale of Sunday passes sold for 20¢ each.

SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Good Cause Appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that ordering paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 40705 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- I. Sacramento City Lines is authorized to establish on one (1) day's notice an adult fare of 10¢ in combination with a token fare of 7¢ sold in blocks of 5 for 35¢, together with a school fare of 5¢. The company is also authorized to discontinue charter rates for buses and the sale of Sunday and weekly passes.

Decision No. 40705 as hereby amended shall become effective on September 29, 1947.
