O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one additional side track at grade across Martha Street in San Jose, Santa Clara County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. E-51.8-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B), and flagging by member of train crew or other competent employee.

This order shall not be construed as authority for deviation from any requirement of G. O. 26-C or any other safety provisions of this Commission.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective twenty days from the date hereof.
