In the matter of application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the construction at grade of railroad industrial spur track upon and along Carroll Avenue and across Shoup Avenue, in the City and County of San Francisco, State of California.

O R D E R

SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Shoup Avenue in San Francisco, at the location described in the application. Shoup Avenue is not open at the point of crossing and this order shall not be deemed authority for such opening. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
