OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant is at present operating its No. 56 Seminary Avenue line over the following route:

From Seminary Avenue and East 14th Street in the City of Oakland, via Seminary Avenue, Hillmont Drive, Sunmist Drive, Edwards Avenue, Greenly Drive, Keller Avenue, Mountain Boulevard to Oak Knoll Hospital, thence via Mountain Boulevard, Golf Links Road, 98th Avenue, Cherokee Avenue, Thermal Street, and 90th Avenue to East 14th Street.

The above route was certificated under certain decisions of this Commission, as enumerated in the 109th Supplemental Application No. 19502.

Applicant now desires to extend its No. 56 Seminary Avenue line from East 14th Street to the vicinity of San Leandro Street over Seminary Avenue.

Applicant alleges that it requires said extension as a means of providing ingress and egress to its new East Oakland Motor Coach Division, and in so operating it will no doubt be called upon to transport passengers into the vicinity of other industries located near Seminary Avenue and San Leandro Street.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted; therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

I. A certificate of public convenience and necessity be and it is hereby granted to Key System Transit Lines authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 2 1/2 of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of passengers over and along the following route:

Along Seminary Avenue between its intersection with East 14th Street and applicant's East Oakland Motor Coach Division located in the vicinity of the intersection of Seminary Avenue and San Leandro Street;

as an extension and enlargement of the operative rights created by the decisions enumerated in the application.

II. In providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

1. Applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from the effective date hereof.
2. Within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof and on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and shall comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79 by filing, in triplicate and making effective, appropriate tariffs.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
