ORDER

Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct an industrial spur track at grade across Railroad Avenue in the City of Eureka, Humboldt County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 5-283.24-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 4 per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign.

All clearances along said track shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-C.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective on the date hereof.
