No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Traffic on Tehama Street shall be protected by member of train crew or other competent employee acting as a flagman

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.
