In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of reilroad industrial drill track in and along North Ninth Street and over, across and upon Rosa Street, in the City of San Jose, County of Santa Clara, State of California.

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an industrial drill track at grade across Rosa Street, said street being partly in the City of San Jose and partly in an unincorporated portion of Santa Clara County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. DA-45.54-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to

Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach conforming with the official grades of said street. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B). Traffic on Rosa Street shall be protected against train movements over said crossing by flagman.

Prior to construction applicant shall file with the Commission certified copy of a permit from the Board of Supervisors of Santa Clara County covering that portion of the crossing lying outside of the City of San Jose.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time

be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
