In the matter of the application of Pacific Greyhound Lines for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate automotive stage service for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express over certain routes in the territory between San Fernando and Long Beach, California and for authority to abandon certain routes in said territory.

First Supplemental Application No. 23462

OPINION

By the first supplement in the above-entitled application, Pacific Greyhound Lines seeks authority to operate a passenger stage service along Manchester Avenue and Sepulveda Boulevard a distance of approximately three miles, as an optional route in its service between Santa Monica and Long Beach. Applicant states that within the last two years the territory adjacent to the intersection of Manchester Avenue and Sepulveda Boulevard has experienced a substantial residential and industrial development, and that many requests have been received for an extension of applicant's service to this area. The district, approximately 12 miles east of applicant's present route along Lincoln Boulevard, is now provided local service by Inglewood City Lines and Pacific Electric Railway Company. Both carriers have indicated by letter that no protest will be made to the authority sought herein by applicant.

It appears that the change proposed herein is in the public interest and should be granted. No hearing is necessary.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Section B (2) of Paragraph V of Decision No. 35241, dated April 14, 1942, be amended by adding the following service

regulation:

- (d) Between the intersection of Sepulveda Boulevard and Lincoln Boulevard, thence along Sepulveda Boulevard to Manchester Avenue, thence along Manchester Avenue to its intersection with Lincoln Boulevard.
- 2. That Paragraph III B of Decision No. 35241 be amended by adding the following restriction against local service:
 - (7) Between the intersection of Sepulveda Boulevard and Lincoln Boulevard, thence along Sepulveda Boulevard to Manchester Avenue, thence along Manchester Avenue to its intersection with Lincoln Boulevard.

The authorization herein granted is subject to the following conditions:

- I. Applicant shall file a written acceptance of the authority herein granted within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from the effective date hereof.
- II. Applicant shall, within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof and upon not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and the public, establish the service herein authorized, and comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A by filing in triplicate and concurrently making effective tariffs and time tables satisfactory to the Commission.

In all other respects Decision No. 35241 shall remain in full force and effect. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
