THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

On February 25, 1947, the Commission issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity to Fieler's Limousines, Inc., authorizing a bus service for airline passengers between Mills Field and various Peninsula cities. (Dec. 40009). Two extensions of time within which to commence service have since been granted, due to delays experienced by applicant in securing vehicles from the manufacturer. (Dec. 40239, May 6, 1947; Dec. 40568, July 29, 1947.)
Service has not been inaugurated.

Applicant, by its counsel, has now requested in writing that the certificate be cancelled. It is alleged that the proposed operation cannot be conducted at a profit, either initially or in the foreseeable future, because of material changes in the economics of the air passenger transport business and the increase in costs of operation of passenger stages engaged in transporting air passengers. Moreover, the airlines which formerly requested the service have now advised applicant that they do not consider it to be necessary under present conditions.

Under the circumstances, it appears that the request for cancellation of the certificate should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Fialer's Limousines, Inc., by Decision No. 40009, as amended by Decision No. 40239 and 40568, be and it is hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days after the date hereof.
