ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one spur track at grade across 8th Street and 7th Street in Chico, Butte County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as portions of Crossings Nos. C-183.95 and C-184.0 respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, and of a width to conform to the portion of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadways and with grades of approach not exceeding six per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Train movements on the track crossings herein authorized shall be flagged. Upon completion, tracks indicated in yellow on map attached to the application shall be removed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
