OPINION AND ORDER

Elva De Pue Matthews operates public utility warehouses at various points in the Sacramento Valley. By this application she seeks authority to sell, and Lawrence Warehouse Company seeks authority to purchase, warehouse property located at Logandale, Glenn County. The consideration involved, 34150, is to be paid in cash.

The verified application shows that Lawrence Warehouse Company has operated public warehouses for many years and that it will provide the same service as that now available. No change in rates is proposed.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Elva De Pue Natthews may, within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof, sell and transfer to Lawrence Warchouse Company the warehouse property involved in this proceeding; and that prior to the effective date of said sale Elva De Pue Matthews and Lawrence Warehouse Company shall,

on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, supplement or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission in so far as they name rates, rules and regulations governing warehouse operations of Elva De Pue Matthews at Logandale, Glenn County, to show that she has withdrawn or cancelled and that Lawrence Warehouse Company has concurrently adopted or established as its own said rates, rules and regulations; and that the tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall in all other respects comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
