authority to construct, operate, and main-  
tain a spur track across an alley between  
Canal and Caspian Avenues in the City of  
Long Beach on its Long Beach-Wilmington Line. )

O R D E R

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across the alley between Canal and Caspian Avenues in the City of Long Beach, at the location described in the application. This alley is not now actually constructed and open to travel at the point of crossing, and this authority shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of said alley across the spur track.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
