FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

On October 10, 1947 the Commission entered its order, Decision No. 40801, authorizing Southern California Edison Company to consummate an agreement submitted with the application as Exhibit A with The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company.

The order in Decision No. 40801 recited that the date of said agreement was July 26, 1947 whereas the date of the agreement as shown on its face is June 26, 1947, therefore

IT IS ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 40801 is hereby modified and amended to read as follows:

"IT IS ORDERED that Southern California Edison Company is hereby authorized to consummate that certain agreement with The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, dated June 26, 1947, a copy of which is attached to the application as Exhibit A, to install the facilities and to render the service therein specified and to charge and collect the rates therein contained."
