O P I N I O N

Applicant requests an extension of one of its lines in the City of Redondo Beach, along Pacific Coast Highway⁽¹⁾ between Torrance Boulevard and Diamond Street, a distance of approximately a half mile.

If the extension is authorized applicant proposes to operate a northbound school trip to the Redondo Union High School at 8:00 a.m. and a southbound trip at 3:30 p.m. No change in fares is proposed. The extension will enable applicant to provide a more direct service between said school and points southerly thereof along applicant's present certificated routes.

Neither the Pacific Greyhound Lines, Pacific Electric Railway Company, nor the City of Redondo opposes this application.

Having fully considered the matter, we are of the opinion and find that public convenience and necessity require the

establishment of the proposed service. The application will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been made in the above-entitled proceeding, the Commission being fully advised, and having found that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity be, and it hereby is, granted to Sunset Stages, a corporation, authorizing it to establish and operate a service as a "passenger stage corporation", as defined in Section 24 of the Public Utilities Act, along Pacific Coast Highway, between Torrance Boulevard and Diamond Street, in the City of Redondo Beach, as an extension of, and to be consolidated with, applicant's present operative rights.

(2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, the following service regulations shall be complied with:

- (a) Applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from the effective date hereof.
- (b) Applicant shall, within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof and upon not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and the public, establish the service herein authorized and comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission.

- (c) Subject to the authority of this Commission to change or modify such at any time, Sunset Stages shall conduct said passenger stage operation over and along the following described route:

Beginning at the intersection of Pacific Coast Highway & Torrance Boulevard, thence northerly along Pacific Coast Highway to its intersection with Diamond Street.

Applicant is authorized to turn its motor vehicles at termini and intermediate points, in either direction, at intersections of streets or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersection, or in accordance with local traffic rules.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
