O P I N I O N

Applicant was recently granted authority to extend its Grant School Line from the intersection of Elena Avenue & Avenue I to the intersection of Pacific Coast Highway & Robert Road (Decision No. 40684).

By this application applicant requests authority to further extend this line into the residential community known as Seaside Ranchos, a distance of approximately three-quarters of a mile, in order to better serve the residents. At present the terminus of the route is on the main highway, requiring passengers to walk several blocks to and from their homes. The proposed service will be an added convenience to the public.

Schedules will be operated hourly between approximately 5:30 a.m. and 11:30 p.m. No increase in fare is proposed.

The application is not opposed.

Full consideration having been given the matter, we are of the opinion that the proposed extension is in the public interest and, therefore, the application will be granted. A public

hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Application as above entitled having been filed, the Commission being fully advised in the premises and hereby finding that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Sunset Stages, a corporation, authorizing establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 24 of the Public Utilities Act, between the intersection of Pacific Coast Highway and Robert Road and the intersection of Reese Road and Linda Drive and intermediate points as an extension of and to be consolidated with the certificate granted by Decision No. 40684.

(2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- a. Applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed 30 days from the effective date hereof.
- b. Within 60 days from the effective date hereof and on not less than 1 day's notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A, by filing in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, appropriate tariffs and time tables.
- c. Subject to the authority of this Commission to change or modify it by further order, applicant shall conduct operations pursuant to the certificate herein granted over and along the following route:

Beginning at the intersection of Pacific Coast Highway and Robert Road, thence along Robert Road, Doris Way, Reese Road to the latter road's intersection with Linda Drive.

Applicant may turn its motor vehicles at termini or intermediate points either in the intersection of the street, or by operating around a block, in either direction, contiguous to such intersection.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
