In the Matter of the Application of GIBSON LINES, a corporation, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity, authorizing it to operate as a Passenger Stage Corporation for the transportation of passengers and their baggage over various routes between Sacramento, North Sacramento, Hagginswood, Del Paso Heights, Robla, Rio Linda, McClellan Field, Carmichael, Fair Oaks, Broderick, Bryte, and West Sacramento, and to consolidate such operation with the remainder of applicant's transportation system.

ORDER

In this application Gibson Lines requests authority to extend its existing service as an extension of and in consolidation with its existing passenger service over an alternate route as hereinafter described, to serve the area adjacent to Fair Oaks Boulevard between Watt Avenue and Carmichael, all within the County of Sacramento.

The purpose of this extension is to serve a fast growing new development in the area involved.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

I. Gibson Lines, a corporation, be and it is hereby granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 22 of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of passengers and their baggage between the intersection of Fair Oaks Boulevard and Watt Avenue and the town of Carmichael, and intermediate points, as an extension of and to be consolidated with applicant's existing service, over and along the route described as follows:

Over Applicant's presently certificated route from Sacramento to the intersection of Fair Oaks Boulevard and Watt Avenue at Arden Park Vista; thence north on La Brea Way to La Sierra Drive; thence northeast on La Sierra Drive to Castec Drive; thence east on Castec Drive to Eastern Avenue; thence south on Eastern Avenue to Fair Oaks Boulevard; thence northeast on Fair Oaks Boulevard to its intersection with Marconi Avenue at Carmichael.

II. In providing the service under the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (1) Applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date hereof.
- (2) Within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof and on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and shall comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A, by filing in triplicate and concurrently making effective appropriate tariffs and time tables.

In all other respects Decision No. 40469 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
