OPINION

G. K. Caye and D. G. Duncan, copartners doing business as the Pomona Motorcycle Delivery Service, provide a parcel delivery service between Pomona, San Bernardino and Riverside and points in the vicinity of these cities. This transportation is subject to minimum rates established by Decision No. 31606 (41 C.R.C. 671), as amended. Petitioners seek exemption from these rates in so far as transportation of shipments of 100 pounds or less is concerned. The petition shows that the service in question differs from that provided by carriers engaged in the transportation of general commodities and is similar to the service of other parcel carriers heretofore exempted from the minimum rates with respect to shipments weighing not more than 100 pounds. It appears that the petition should be granted. Public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 31606, as amended, in Case No. 4246, be and it is hereby further amended by adding G. K. Caye and D. G. Duncan, copartners, to the list of carriers

set forth in paragraph (c) of Finding No. 14 thereof.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
