## ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Fourth Street South and Shady Lane in the town of Coachella, Riverside County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. B-614.38-C and B-614.92-C, respectively. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of widths to conform to the portions of streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadways and with grades of approach not exceeding 2%. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs at each location, G.O. No. 75-B.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in Writing. This authorization tion shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
