ORDER

In Decision No. 29457 on Application No. 20935 the Commission approved an agreement between Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, California Western Railroad and Navigation Company and Willits Lumber Company covering the maintenance and operation of certain tracks and facilities in and in the vicinity of Willits, Mendocino County.

The railroad companies now desire to extend the provisions of this agreement to include joint operation of certain additional tracks owned by them in the vicinity, and in Application No. 28926 have requested authority to enter into a supplemental agreement to cover. The request is reasonable and should be granted, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company and California Western Railroad and Navigation Company are authorized to enter into an agreement supplemental to the agreement of November 20, 1936, approved by the Commission in Decision No. 29457 in Application No. 20935, extending the terms of said agreement to cover joint operations by applicants over the trackage shown by solid red line and dashed red line on the print attached to the application, subject to the condition that applicants file with the Commission a certified copy of such supplemental agreement within thirty (30) days after its execution. This authority shall become

null and void unless exercised within one year from the effective date of this order unless further time be granted.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
