ORDER

Santa Clara County is authorized to construct South 10th Street and South 7th Street at grade across a branch line track of The Western Pacific Railroad Company and a joint drill track of The Western Pacific Railroad Company and Southern Pacific Company near San Jose, Santa Clara County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as follows:

Crossings with branch line of The Western Pacific Railroad Company	
7th Street	Crossing No. 4-19.4
10th Street	Crossing No. 4-19.2
Crossings with joint Western Pacific - Southern Pacific drill track	
7th Street	Crossing No. 4-19.9-C
10th Street	Crossing No. 4-20.1-C

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The respective railroad companies shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than the graded width of said street, and grades of approach not greater than one per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of C.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (C. O. No. 75-B) at each crossing.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified

if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
