O P I N I O N

By his application, as amended, Walter A. Junge sought a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the operation of a highway common carrier service between San Francisco, South San Francisco, Oakland, Alameda, Emeryville, Albany, Berkeley and Richmond, on the one hand, and Pittsburg and Antioch and intermediate points, on the other hand. The application was opposed by the carriers in the field, as indicated above. The matter was called for hearing before Examiner Austin at San Francisco on

August 11, 1947 and continued until a later date. At the outset of the subsequent hearing at San Francisco on December 15, 1947, applicant's counsel moved to dismiss the proceeding and the matter was thereupon submitted. An order will be entered accordingly.

Application as above entitled having been filed, a public hearing having been held thereon, applicant having moved to dismiss the proceeding, the matter having been duly submitted, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the above entitled proceeding be and it hereby is dismissed.
