## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Public Utilities Commission by Decision No. 40589, dated August 5, 1947, in the above entitled matter, authorized California Motor Express, Ltd., on or before October 31, 1947, to execute a deed of trust and to issue a note for \$150,000 for the purpose of paying, in part, the cost of terminal properties in Los Angeles, and

WHEREAS, the company reports that due to unanticipated delays in construction it has not been required to execute the deed of trust or to issue the note but that through an oversight it did not ask for an extension of the time limit specified in said Decision No. 40589, and

WHEREAS, the company now reports that the terminal is approaching completion, that it will be necessary for it to issue its note during December, 1947, and that accordingly it desires an extension of time, therefore,

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. California Motor Express, Ltd. may, on or before January 31, 1948, execute the deed of trust and issue the note

for \$150,000 which were authorized by Decision No. 40589, dated August 5, 1917.

2. The order in Decision No. 40589, dated August 5, 1947, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
