O P I N I O N

M. C. Yahne, Inc., doing business as Inland Stages, pursuant to the authority of Decision No. 39633 dated November 19, 1946, in Application No. 27641 is conducting a passenger stage service between a point on the California-Nevada State Line north of Coleville, California, and Los Angeles via Bishop and Mojave; between Los Angeles and San Diego via Elsinore and Escondido, and between Elsinore and San Bernardino via Riverside and Colton.

The Commission is requested to authorize M. C. Yahne, Inc., to transfer the above described operative right to Pacific Greyhound Lines and the latter requests authority to acquire such operative right.

According to the application Pacific Greyhound Lines now owns all of the outstanding capital stock of M. C. Yahne, Inc., and the authority as herein requested is to enable applicants to consummate the acquisition and merger heretofore authorized by the Interstate Commerce Commission. Applicant Pacific Greyhound Lines upon consummation of the acquisition and merger proposes to continue all the passenger stage operations presently conducted by M. C. Yahne, Inc.

Upon full consideration it is our conclusion that the

proposed merger is in the public interest and should be authorized.
No public hearing is necessary.

O R D E R

An application therefor having been filed, the Commission being fully informed therein and it being found that the proposal of applicants is in the public interest and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That M. C. Yahne, Inc., may on or before March 31, 1948, transfer to Pacific Greyhound Lines and the latter may acquire, merge and consolidate with its present operative rights, the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 39633 in Application No. 27641.

(2) That applicants shall comply with the provisions of General Orders Nos. 79 and 80 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, appropriate tariffs and time tables within 60 days from the date hereof and on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
