FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Public Utilities Commission by Decision No. 39865, dated January 21, 1947, authorized Thunderbird Water Company, among other things, to issue and sell at not less than \$100 a share, 230 shares of its common capital stock for the purpose of paying the cost of constructing and installing a water system to serve a tract of land in Riverside County referred to in said decision, and of providing working capital, such sale of stock to be made on or before December 31, 1947, and

WHEREAS, in a supplemental application filed with the Commission on December 17, 1947, Thunderbird Water Company reports that its water system has not yet been completed and that therefore it has issued no stock, and

WHEREAS, applicant asks the Commission to extend the time within which applicant may issue said shares of stock, and

WHEREAS, the Commission has considered applicant's request and believes that said request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which Thunderbird Water Company may issue and sell the stock authorized by the order in Decision No. 39885, dated January 21, 1947, be and it hereby is, extended to and including June 30, 1948.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 39885, dated January 21, 1947, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
